- We are exceptionally proud of our end of KS2 SATS results for the academic year 2023 / 2024
- Outcomes for all subjects exceed both national and Richmond averages
- Outcomes for children exceeding the average expectation and therefore working at the greater depth standards exceed national averages in all subjects and exceed Richmond averages in reading and maths.
- There is a 6% increase of children achieving greater depth in writing 2024 compared to 2023
