SUMMER TERM CLUBS – PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

Dear Families,

Attached to this email you will find a list of extra-curricular clubs that we are keen to run in the Summer Term 2026.

Each club provider has a 'minimum' amount of children that they require to join, in order for it to be viable for their club to go ahead, so please anticipate that some clubs may not take place.

Clubs will begin the week commencing the **20th April** until, and including, the week commencing the **6th July**. Please note that Monday clubs are running for 1 less week due to the bank holiday on Monday 4th May and a few clubs are running for less due to prior commitments of the club provider. **Club dates can be found on the clubs' timetable, please check these carefully before booking.**

All of our club providers, with the exception of the school run clubs, will **only** be taking bookings and payment directly. The information on how to book is provided on the attached club timetable. **Please book your child's place by Wednesday 15th April**. You will be advised by the provider at the time of booking whether your child has a place. Children will not be able to start any club until payment has been received.

For the school run clubs, please complete the relevant google form within the club timetable by Wednesday 15th April 2026.

Please note the following for the summer term's clubs:

Gardening Club is returning for the summer term on Wednesday afternoons

Make and Create Club will now be on Thursdays after school

Real Runners Athletics Club – please sign up on the google form within the club timetable. **We will only contact you if the club is oversubscribed and it is not possible for your child to attend.**

Taekwon-Do – a new club for summer term 2026 run by London TKD on Thursday mornings. Please see the flyer attached to the email for more information

Although not part of this club letter, please also note that external music lessons provided take some time out of your child's timetable. If you would like to find out exactly what your child will miss during their music lesson time, please check with your child's teacher. If you would like more information on the external music lessons, please contact the office, Mrs Thomas or Richmond Music Trust directly.

For safeguarding reasons, children attending the morning clubs MUST be dropped off by their parents or guardians.
